## Measures against the Jews

The evacuation of Jews out of Belgium was brought to a temporary conclusion in the report period. In total, <u>16,882 Jews were evacuated from Belgium</u> on 14 transport trains. In addition, great numbers of Jews are fleeing Belgium, a development that could not be prevented despite tighter border controls. The remaining Jews in the country are in hiding, meaning that the deportations planned for a later date will be very difficult to carry out. According to rough estimates, there are currently still <u>10,000 Jews</u>, including those of Belgian nationality, <u>in Belgium</u>.
