SECRET

Dear SS (party member) Wolf,

With reference to our telephone conversation of 16 July, I wish to pass on to you the following report from my General Directorate of the Eastern Railways (Ostbahnen) (Gedob) at Cracow for your information:

"Since 22 July one train per day with 5 000 Jews, goes from Warsaw via Malkinia to Treblinka, as well as the trains per week with 5 000 Jews each, from Przemysl to Belzek. Gedob (General-Direktion of the Eastern Railways) is in constant touch with the Security Service at Cracow. The latter agrees that transports from Warsaw via Lublin to Sobibor (near Lublin) should be interrupted, as long as building on this route makes these transports impossible (about October 1942)."

This train service has been fixed in agreement with the Chief of the Security Service for the General-Gouvernement and Police-Fuehrer of the district of Lublin, SS-Brigadefuehrer Globotschnigg, has been informed.
