To the Commander SS-Obersturmbannführer Hoess KL Auschwitz.

Subject: Delivery [Antransport] of Jewish armaments workers. From Berlin.

I once more point out that the Jewish armaments workers from Berlin, whose transport left yesterday, definitely have to stay able to work. Due to the fact that they were working in the armaments industry in Berlin, their usefulness can be seen. Firstly the Buna Camp has to be brought to full height.

Thereby I appeal that in any case, that the unloading doesn't take place at the usual place but expediently directly at the Bunawerk.

I therefore await a significant rise of the numbers at the Bunawerk in the next few days.
